FELLOWSHIP IN CORNEA & REFRACTIVE

This Cornea fellowship @ Dr. Agarwals offers intensive training in cornea and refractive surgeries.

Academic Activities:

- Grand Rounds, Case Presentations, Clinical Discussions, Quarterly Assessments

Hands-on Surgical Training:

- Corneal surgeries – Penetrating keratoplasties, DALK, DSEK and PDEK
- Refractive surgeries – Microkeratome assisted Lasik, Femtolasik and SMILE
- Phaco & Glued IOL procedures
- CAIRS

- Lacrimal Surgries – Probing, DCR, Silicone Intubation

- Cosmetic Procedures

This fellowship program offers a comprehensive training in the diagnosis and management of medical and surgical diseases of the vitreous and retina. It also involves training in cataract surgeries to enable the fellow to evolve as a complete surgeon.

- Grand Rounds, Case Presentations, Clinical Discussions, Quarterly Assessments

Clinical Training:

- Indirect ophthalmoscopy
- Interpretation & Clinical Correlation of Fundus Fluorescein Angiography, Optical Coherence Tomography and Ultrasonography
- Lasers and Cryopexy
- Administration of intravitreal injections.

Hands-on Surgical Training:

- Scleral buckling
- Retinal detachment surgeries
- Pars plana vitrectomies (Vitreous haemorrhage, Nucleus drop, IOL drop, Endophthalmitis)
- Macular surgeries
- Ocular trauma cases
- Phaco & Glued IOLs

The Fellow will have rotational postings in other speciality departments also.

FELLOWSHIP IN GLAUCOMA

This Glaucoma fellowship @ Dr. Agarwals offers intensive training in glaucoma management.

Academic Activities:

- Grand Rounds, Case Presentations, Clinical Discussions, Quarterly Assessments

Clinical Training:

A) Comprehensive Training in the Evaluation and Diagnosis of Glaucoma that includes

- Tonometry, Gonioscopy and Disc Evaluation
- Interpretation and Clinical Correlation of Visual Field and Optical Coherence Tomography (OCT) of Disc and Retinal Nerve Fibre Layer
- Other Modalities of Investigation involved in Glaucoma Diagnosis - Ultrasound Pachymetry, Ultrasound biomicroscopy, Anterior Segment - OCT

B) Approach to the Medical and Surgical Management of Different Types of Glaucoma (Primary and Secondary Glaucoma) that includes hands-on training in

- Out-Patient Procedures like Laser Iridotomy
- Cyclodestructive Procedure - Cyclocryotherapy

C) Training in Pre- and Post-operative Care of Glaucoma Patients

Hands-on Surgical Training:

- Cataract Surgeries - Phacoemulsification, Small Incision Cataract Surgery (SICS)
- Glaucoma Surgeries - Trabeculectomy, Combined Surgeries (Phacoemulsification + Trabeculectomy, SICS + Trabeculectomy)

FELLOWSHIP IN PHACO REFRACTIVE

The fellowship offers adequate exposure to Cataract Surgeries and Keratorefractive surgeries.

Clinical Training:

- Comprehensive training in pre-operative assessment and work up for both cataract surgeries and keratorefractive surgeries.
- Ample exposure to imaging modalities like PENTACAM, ABERROMETRY, ASOCT, LIPIVIEW
- Training in pre and post-operative care and counselling of patients undergoing keratorefractive surgery and lens based refractive surgery.
- Dry Eye Evaluation and diagnostics
- Keratoconus – evaluation and management

Hands-on Surgical Training:

- SICS
- Phacoemulsification
- Glued IOL
- Excimer Laser (PRK, BLADE LASIK) FEMTO Laser (FL, ReLEX SMILE)

- Fundus fluorescein angiography
- Ultrasound biomicroscopy
- Ultrasound B scan

Preoperative and post-operative management of complicated cataract:

- Surgical exposure to - Cataract Surgeries – Phacoemulsification, Small Incision Cataract Surgery (SICS)
- Hands on training in - Inj Posterior subtenon and Intravitreal steroids

Clinical interpretation of investigations as below

- Grand Rounds, Clinical Discussions, Quarterly Assessments.
- Opportunity to work in Research paper on topics of uveitis and its related treatment modalities – including learning on data collection and basic analysis.
